PROCESS	A panel of dance experts, including the Director(s) of the High Point Ballet, will adjudicate the High Point Ballet auditions. It is important to understand the adjudication process is subjective. The auditions will begin as close to the designated time as possible. The adjudication process begins as soon as the dancer walks onto the dance floor. No parents, guardians, or caretakers will be allowed in the audition studio. Adjudicators will observe each dancer as they perform a variety of movements. Results of the audition, which is the placement level beginning this summer, will be distributed in a timely manner.
