<p>REGISTRATION FEES TUITION FEES <b>(Non-refundable)</b> AND STUDY REQUIREMENTS <b>(Mandatory)</b></p> <p>PAYMENTS:  MAKE PAYMENTS TO: HIGH POINT BALLET</p> <p>Tuition may be paid in full or by monthly and may be auto-drafted on a credit or debit card. (Multiple children discount applies only to payment in full). Payments in full qualify for a 5% discount, with the exception of production and summer tuition fees, and is due April 15<sup>th</sup> for the 20-21 season. Monthly payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup>, past due on the 5<sup>th</sup> and subject to a \$35 late fee after the 5<sup>th</sup>. Upon enrollment, financial responsibility is assumed for all fees for the current term which includes Summer 2020 and 2020-2021 Season tuition, Nutcracker and Spring production fees, and membership fees regardless of early withdrawal. <b>These fees are non-refundable.</b></p> <p><b>Registration Fee: \$50.00</b> Paid once a calendar year. Due June 1, along with summer application.</p> <p>SUMMER session is June 15- July 10. Tuition is due June 1</p> <p>20-21 SEASON is August 1, 2020-June 13, 2021. Tuition is due beginning August 1, 2020. ## General Release/Indemnification Form

In case of an emergency, if the staff of the High Point Ballet is unable to reach me by phone, concerning a situation that requires immediate emergency medical assistance, I hereby give my permission to the staff to secure treatment for my child as named in this application.
